2009 Journal Dinner Dance Guidelines

1. Tickets to the Journal dinner will be \$425 per couple and \$225 for single tickets.
2. Tickets may be earned by securing ads or paying for them, or any combination of the two. For example, (for two tickets) if you obtain \$200 in ads, you will only be required to pay the \$225 difference. If you have already paid your annual assessment fee (which is required of all members), that amount will also be credited to the price of the tickets. Conversely, if you haven't, the payment for the tickets will be credited to your assessment fee. (It makes sense to come and enjoy a wonderful night out!!!!!!)
3. All ads must be accompanied with payment from the merchants. All requests for tickets to the dinner must be accompanied with payment (or payment balance).
4. We cannot transfer ads from one member to another.
5. Ads and ticket payments may not be used to credit a member's Synagogue account. If you collect more money in ads than the required amount to pay for your ticket, know that you are doing a mitzvah for our Shul and that we need and appreciate it.
6. For business card ads or merchant ad copies, crisp clean reproductions are necessary to assure that they look presentable in the Journal book. Please keep staples, etc., off of them.
7. As a courtesy to the office staff and for planning purposes, please let the office know if you are planning to attend this year's dinner on Sunday, May 31st as early as you can.
